

Children's Ministries: Babies are always welcome in the Sanctuary during worship. We also have a nursery (accessible through the breezeway in the back of the Sanctuary). First Church offers child care for ages 3 months to 3 years with professional nursery staff on Sundays 9:45am-11:45am. Sunday School classes are known as "Disciple Road" (Age 4 through 4th grade) and "Middle Road" (5th grade and up). We also have a children's choir. We have a new **hearing assist system** available. Download the WaveCast Audio Receiver app by Williams Sound for your smartphone and it will sync with your wifi or Bluetooth enabled hearing aid, so you can hear the service through your own hearing aid. 
